## **FAQs**

What is the MS Society? The <u>National MS</u> <u>Society</u> supports people living with multiple sclerosis and funds research to find a cure. Donations are encouraged!

What is the MS150? This is a supported bike ride with two starts (Houston and Austin) to College Station and has been one of the largest fundraising sources for the MS Society for 45 years. Some of the riders have MS themselves.

When do I have to decide? We would like you to register by March 14, 2025 and please let us know if you have to cancel.



#### MS150 Volunteer Registration Steps

- 1. Open the <u>MS Society Volunteer link</u>
- 2. Click "Sign Up!" to create an account
- Step 1: You can sign up with your FB account or email, fill out your information and click "CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT"
- 4. Step 2: select your skills and interest (or you can leave blank), then click "CONTIUE TO NEXT STEP"
- 5. Click "CONTINUE" on the next screen
- 6. You will see: "Opportunity: (2025) Bike MS: ACC Texas MS150 - Day 1 Austin Route Rest Stop #3 Volunteers - Buescher State Park", then fill out the Events Questions below, check that you have read and agreed to the consent form, then click "JOIN TEAM"

**Do I have to camp**? No if camping isn't your thing, you can just join us there Saturday morning! There are a few cabins (sleeps 4) for camping if you don't want to tent camp.

**Do I have to bring my own food?** Yes – this is a volunteer event and everyone needs to bring their own supplies and food. The rest stop supplies will be provided by the MS Society.
